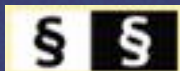

Open	Any player may enter, FIDE and ECF rated
Major	For players rated under 1950, standard play, ECF rated
Intermediate	For players rated under 1750, standard play, ECF rated
Foundation	For players rated under 1500, standard play, ECF rated



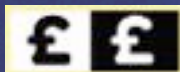
Schedule

Friday	Saturday	Sunday
Opening 18:50	Rd 2 10:00	Rd 4 10:00
Rd 1 19:00	Rd 3 15:00	Rd 5 15:00

Default and re-pairing time: 30 mins after the scheduled start times.

Rate of play: All moves in 90 mins, plus 30 second increment throughout.

Byes: Except for round 5, players may request one half point bye.



Entry fees etc

Open £42 (ECF gold members, and above, may deduct £12). Only players with at least ECF gold membership can claim discount in the Open tournament.

Other tournaments £39 (ECF silver members, and above, may deduct £9).

Juniors (U18 on 1st September) may deduct £5 across all tournaments.

October FIDE and ECF ratings determine eligibility to play in different tournaments. When a player has both an ECF and a FIDE rating, the FIDE rating will be used in the Open and ECF rating will be used in the other three tournaments. If your rating increases between entering the Congress and the publication of the October list, this may mean a change in tournament allocation. This will be shown on the Torbay Chess Congress website. If you wish to withdraw as a result, please contact the Congress Secretary who will arrange a full refund of your entry fee. Alternatively, your rating may decrease. If you become eligible for a lower tournament, and you wish to change, you should contact the Congress Secretary before 6th November 2024.



Prizes

Prizes for each tournament: 1st £240, 2nd £140, 3rd £85.

We give generous rating and slow starter (0/2) prizes according to the number of entries. Unrated players may not win rating prizes and not more than £50 in any tournament except the Open. Unrated players must provide evidence of previous ratings and recent performances in other competitions on a separate sheet.

A prize is awarded to the top team of 4 players from the same club.

Team entries must be submitted before the end of round 2.
